

Code of Conduct

Not complying with the rules outlined in the Code of Conduct can result in immediate removal and/or disqualification from the Imagine_BGKY Hackathon at the discretion of Hackathon staff, volunteers, or organizers. As well as behavior, content created at our hackathon is equally subject to these policies.

Any and all illegal activities are grounds for immediate disqualification & removal.

Harassment & Discrimination

We are dedicated to providing a high-quality, harassment-free experience for everyone, regardless of age, ancestry, disability, ethnicity, gender identity and expression, nationality, physical appearance, race, religion, sexual orientation, or any other basis of identity. Similarly, there will be no negative treatment of participants based on experience or lack of experience with hackathons, computing, specific programming languages, or tech stacks.

Harassment can include making verbal remarks, creating or sharing offensive images, deliberate intimidation, stalking or following, photography or audio/video recording against reasonable consent, sustained disruption of talks or other events, inappropriate physical contact, and unwelcome sexual attention. Participants asked to stop any harassing behavior shall comply immediately.

Discrimination and harassment of any kind will not be tolerated. If a participant engages in harassing behavior, the hackathon staff and volunteers may take any action deemed appropriate by the hackathon organizers. This includes warning the offender, expulsion from the hackathon, or reporting their behavior to local law enforcement.

If you are being harassed, notice that someone else is being harassed, or have any other concerns, please contact a member of the hackathon staff immediately.

Sexual Content

Sexual language, imagery, and advancements are not appropriate during any part of the Imagine_BGKY Hackathon or within material relating to or stemming from the hackathon. This includes (but is not limited to) hacks, presentations and demos, social media, and interactions with hackathon participants, staff, and volunteers.

Photography

Photography is allowed, but other participants must be allowed to opt out of being photographed or videoed. If someone requests not to be included in any recording, you must comply with their request. Do not take photographs in contexts where people have a reasonable expectation of privacy (e.g., bathrooms, while sleeping).
